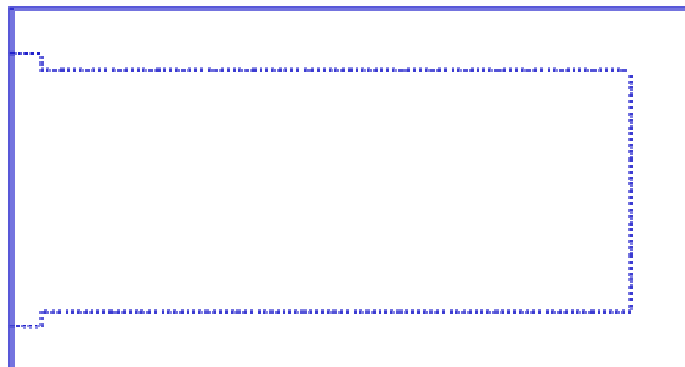
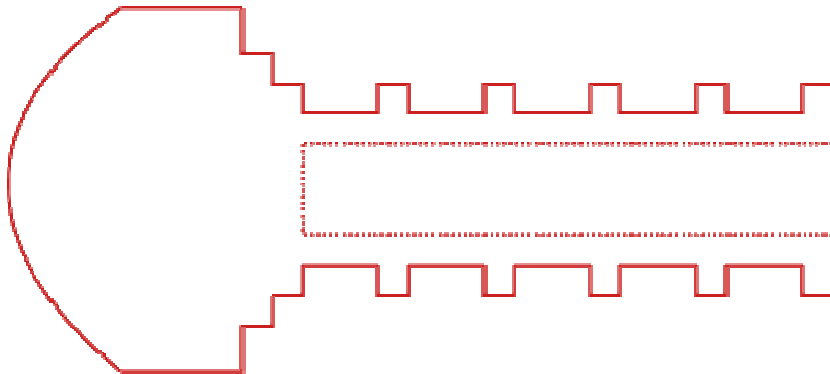


Authentic Roman Centurian's Sewing Kit

In one part he visits the museum and is shown, amongst other things, one of these sewing kits that used to be carried by the Roman Centurian's circa 80A.D. I thought these were far more practical than the small ladies sewing kits as you could actually get your hands on the thing without feeling as if it would break. After doing one it is surprising how many ladies have since wanted one, well after the conversation piece at parties it is still very practical.

The plan above is deliberately vague as you can put your own interpretation to it. This one was 25mm diameter x 95mm high to give you some idea.
